

Non-Resident Library Card Policy

Non-Resident Cards:

The non-resident card rate is determined by IC 36-12-2-25(c) and set each year by the Adams Public Library System Board of Trustees. The non-resident card is valid for one year from date of issue.

Many local townships will provide a voucher that pays for part or all of the cost of the card. Township residents may contact trustees to obtain a voucher.

Partial Year Rates:

Non-residents may purchase a partial year card.

Non-Resident Family Member:

Additional family members who reside in the same household of the primary cardholder may purchase a non-resident annual card or partial year card at the rate of \$5.00 per additional family member. Separate cards will be issued to each participating family member and will be valid as long as the primary member's card is valid.
